#### News from the Trailhead

Thanks to volunteer Jim Tyndall, The Ridges will soon have a beautifully handcrafted sign which identifies the property at Hwy 57 & Ridges Road as the Future Trailhead and Interpretive Center for The Ridges Sanctuary.

With spring fast approaching, you can expect to see more activity on and around the site. For the next two months, we will be focused on *recycling of the existing buildings*. Several contractors are interested in helping take apart the buildings to obtain material that can be put to immediate use on other existing construction projects. As much of the remaining material as possible will be recycled, with a number of items going to the Habitat for Humanity ReStore. Our goal is to build awareness in Door County on options for recycling building construction material.

Trail clearing for the new handicapped accessible boardwalk will take place in March and April with construction to begin this summer, assuming funding is available.

#### The Ridges' Outreach

The Ridges Sanctuary (TRS) coordinated the Door County Invasive Species Team (DCIST) education and outreach activities during the 2010 and 2011 seasons. We reached more diverse groups by educating them on how to identify and control invasive species in their backyards. In 2012, TRS will continue invasive species outreach by sharing our knowledge of local environmental resources to participants through our Landowner Stewardship Program.

This season we are also working to meet a critical need on the Door Peninsula by working with the US Fish and Wildlife Service in developing better

methods of protecting groundwater areas that feed Hine's Emer-

ald dragonfly (HED) habitat.

Eleven groundwater contribution areas and the correlating HED larval sites exist on the Door County Peninsula, and one of them happens to be the future home of *our new interpretive center*. By implementing one or more of these best management practices and educating landowners and local governments, TRS will be an active leader in setting a positive community example.
