Guided Snowshoe Hikes

Experience The Ridges in a whole new way and a whole new season! These hikes with a Ridges naturalist cover the cultural and natural history of the ridges and swales in their winter season. Enjoy a leisurely hike on level terrain. Participants may always hike in boots or, if sufficient snow cover, may choose snowshoes. Hike will end at the Center with a cup of hot chocolate or locally roasted coffee.





Saturday, February 2, 9:00 - 11:00 AM


We invite you to join the staff and volunteers of The Ridges for the *Great Waffle Breakfast*.


