



Birdy, It's Cold Outside!

A great way to watch birds up close is to set out a simple feeder during the cold weather. The Ridges is offering two opportunities to make simple feeders for winter birdwatching.

At the November Early Birder's meeting, we will make feeders from simple, recycled products. Learn about Project Feeder Watch, and then we'll see what kinds of birds are still hanging around the Sanctuary. The Early Birders program has grown with 19 members and that many or more accompanying adults. the Range Light

Lower Range Light Renovations! Since The Ridges Sanctuary's beginning in 1937, the Lower Range Light has served as an icon of the unique area of biodiversity that surrounds it. It is in need of restoration to preserve the historic structure. Because of the historic nature of the Range Lights, there are restrictions on how the work must be done. Volunteers will be doing much of the work—especially our awesome Wednesday Crew aided by Board Member Bob Ryan. Please consider helping with this much needed project. To date, the Restore the Range Light fund has raised over \$7,000 but we've hit an obstacle—the foundation is in urgent need of repair so that is our first priority.

Trail Talk at The Ridges

- Door County had a bad wind storm on September 29th. It fried our office server so we are improvising until we can get something else up and running. Thanks to Nancyanne & Frank Soprano, we have a reserve to cover this problem.
- The storm closed all the state parks in Door County. Many people found their way to The Ridges Sanctuary to hike and enjoy its natural beauty.
- The Fall Volunteer Day was a success! Because of the generosity of business member, Timberline Tree Services, we had LOTS of wood chips that were put down on the trails. There's even some left for the Spring Volunteer Day (mark your calendars) May 5, 2012! Volunteers with chain saws were out clearing the trails on Saturday and then came back for the Chili and fixin's at noon. That combread was MMMmmm!
- The Barberry Pirates have fought a good fight! They have banished crown vetch from the beach, pulled barberry and honeysuckle out by the roots, battled Japanese Knotweed, black swallow-wort, and Eurasian Swamp Thistle. Because of them, our Sanctuary flora and fauna have a better place to live and flourish.
- The Memories book will be published in Spring. Cathleen Haskins has compiled over 50 stories from Ridges' members and friends. Watch for more news about this in January.
